■Answer the following condition problems for the final hand, given the point situation below.

South 4, 1 honba Dealer: A Leftover riichi sticks: 1,000 points.
 A East 39200 ※Rules: JPML competition rules, A-rules
 B South 20800
 C West 26000
 D North 33000

1) For B and C, state the winning-score condition needed for their placement points to become positive. Give each answer separately. (1 point each)

- ※ Use the minimum sufficient winning score (Assume hands of 80 fu or above do not occur)
- ※ Do not include honba points in your answer. (Example: 1000, 2000)

2) For C and D, state the winning-score condition needed for them to finish first. Give each answer separately. (2 points each)

- ※ Use the minimum sufficient winning score (Assume hands of 80 fu or above do not occur)
- ※ Do not include honba points in your answer. (Example: 1000, 2000)
- ※ A tie for first place is also acceptable

4) Write B's hand at the point on turn 9 when B drew [三] and discarded [南].

- ※ Follow the example answer below, writing tiles in this order: manzu, souzu, pinzu.

5) As recorded, this hand ended with B winning by tsumo on turn 12, and B finished the hanchan in first place.

From the overall hand and discard situation, infer B's draws and discards on turns 10 and 11, then answer with B's final tenpai shape (excluding the winning tile) and the winning tile. (Both must be correct for 5 points.)

- ※ Assume A and B have not declared riichi.
- ※ Assume a player in tenpai does not pass up a winning tile.
- ※ Follow the example answer below, writing tiles in this order: manzu, souzu, pinzu.
